Reporting and Analysis: Admin can generate reports on request trends, volunteer activity, and overall system performance to improve efficiency.

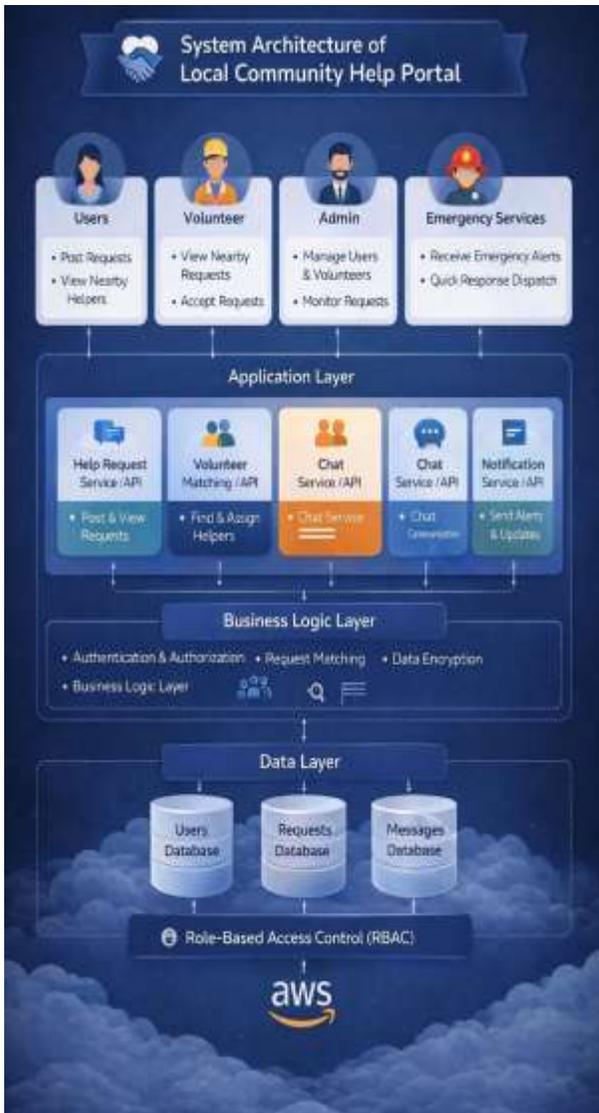


Fig 1: - System Architecture

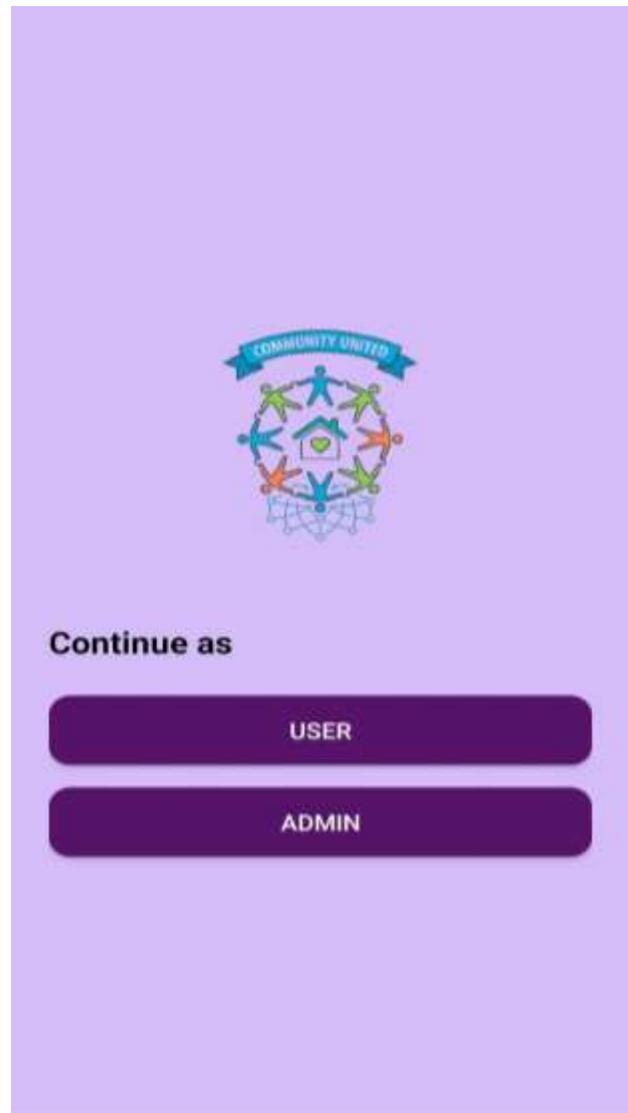


Fig 2: - Login Module

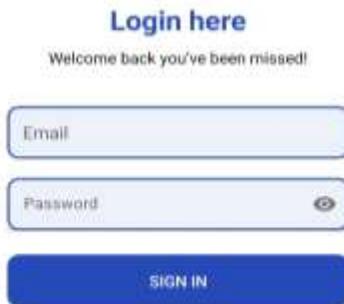


Fig 3:- Admin Login

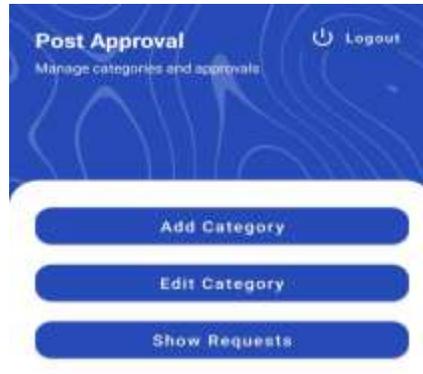


Fig 4:- Post Approval

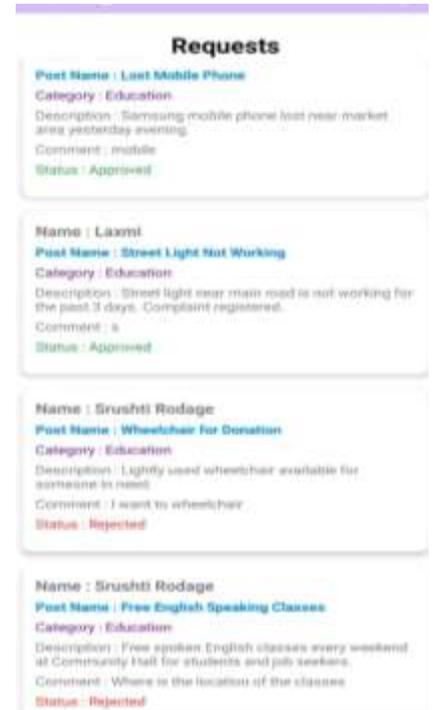


Fig 5 :- Requests

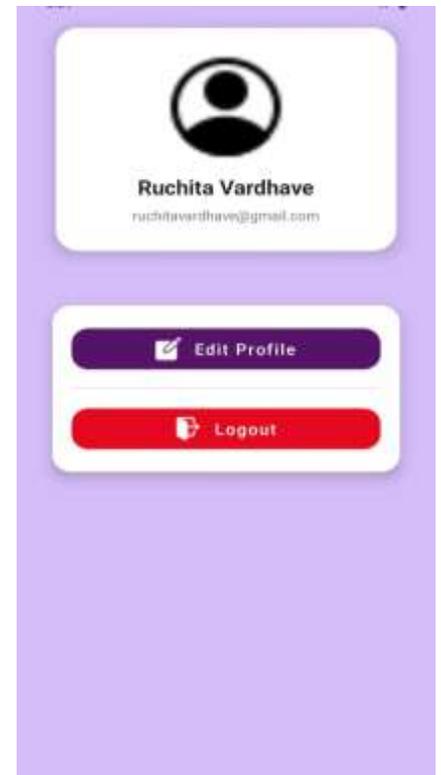


Fig 8:- Profile

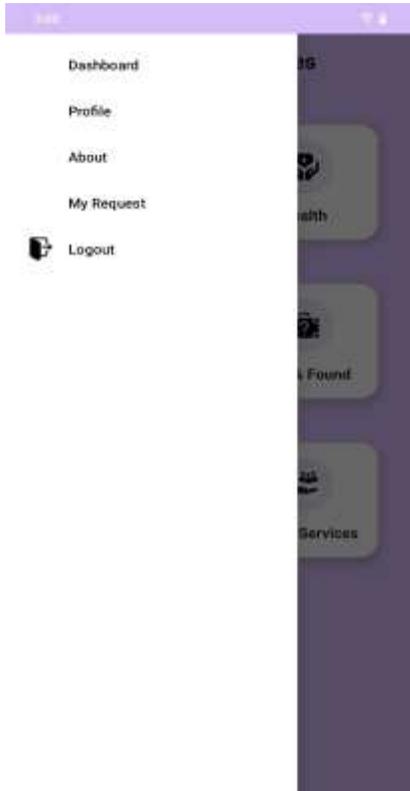


Fig9: - Menu

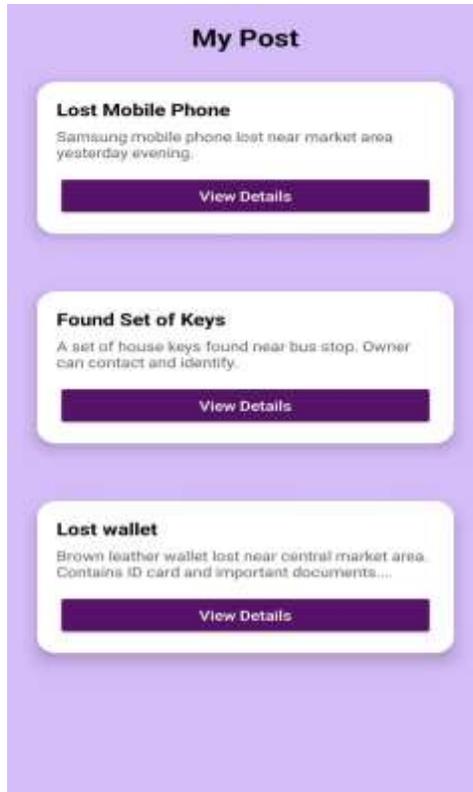


Fig10: - My Post

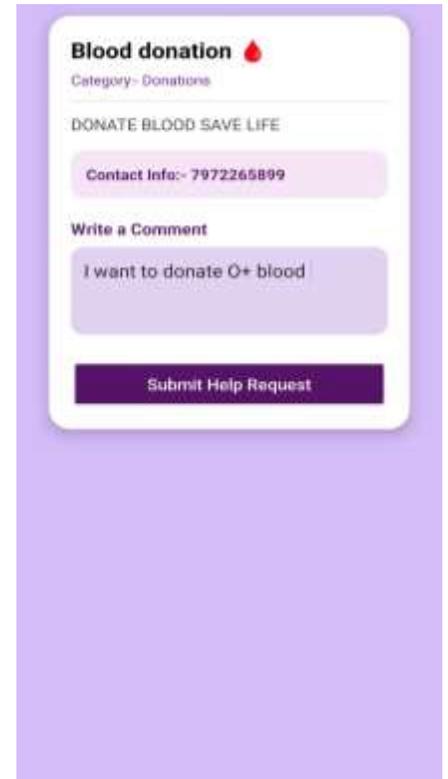


Fig 11: Category

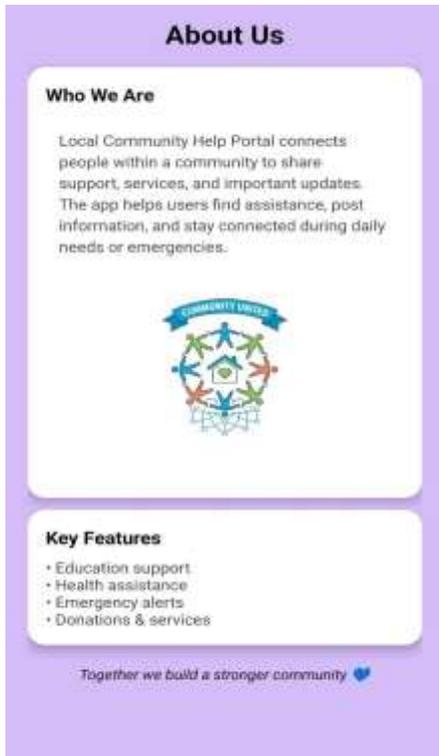


Fig 12: About
