Incorporating soft skills training alongside technical education ensures a holistic approach to skill development, making youth more attractive to potential employers.



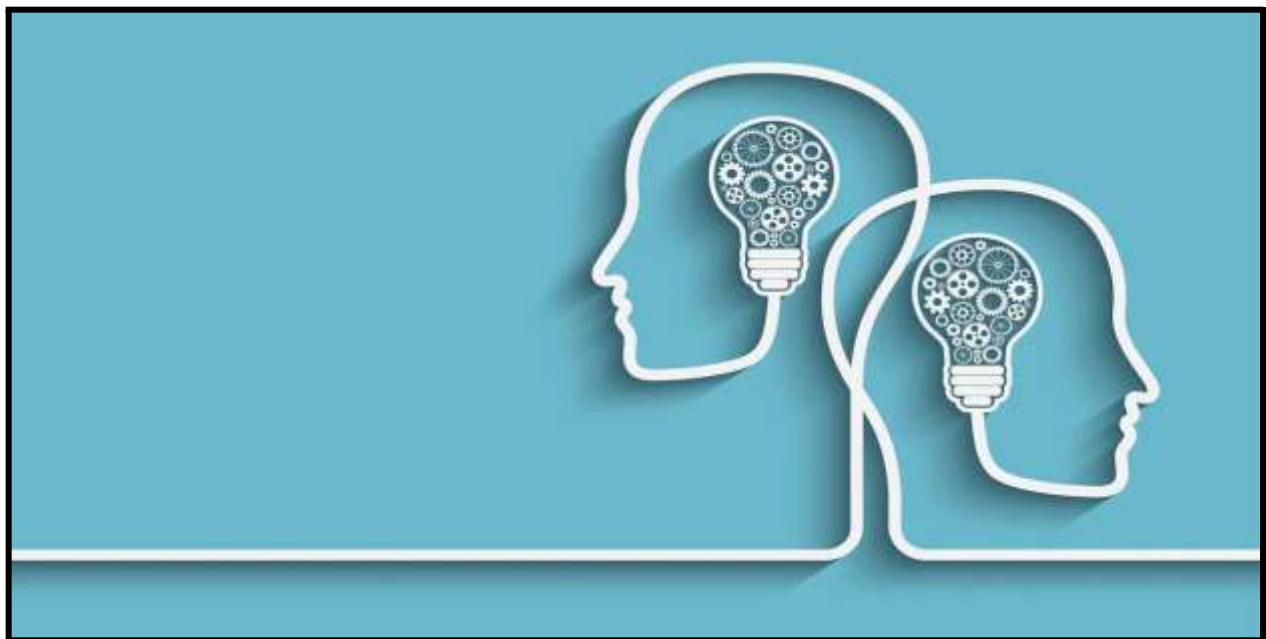
6. Case Study: Saksham Yuva Scheme in Haryana
