Abstract



CHALLENGES IN ENTREPRENEURSHIP WOMEN

1. TRADITIONAL MINDSET

The tradition and culture has impact on women to mostly spend their lives in doing the house works only, where the male dominate the outer world. Such kind of mindset and culture keep them afar from achieving their goals of being an entrepreneur.

2. FINANCIAL PROBLEMS

No permission to take or involve in the financial decision making process leads to financial problems. Govt. need to boost up

3. LACK OF ENTREPRENEURIAL TRAINING

Lac of entrepreneurship knowledge and training in regular curriculum and awareness amongst the non farm sector in rural area resultsin unemployment.

4. LACK OF FACILITY

As the rural areas have no availability of basic facilities there is great issue of facility for the rural entrepreneur.

5. UNABLE TO TAKE RISK

Women From rural area are mostly housewife or few working with very low income as purchasing capacity of people is very less. They are not educated to take risk. They are conservative and can't take risk of big investment.

6. NETWORKING:

Creating network in rural area seems to be difficult.

For women in rural area as they are not trained for business and dealing with customers. Nature of business depend on paying capacity of customers.

7. MALE DOMINATED SOCIETY

Normally in rural areas decision making in family is only men. Though they talk about equality, in reality, the women are not taken in confidence of major decisions.

8. LESS CONFIDENCE ABOUT BUSINESS SUCCESS

Unawareness and lac of knowledge about entrepreneurship canmake women low self-confidence. They don't get family support and encouragement to make them to stand on their own feet.

CASE STUDY - A SUCCESS OF RURAL ENTREPREURESHIP

Green Fab Solar Khadi Processing Cluster, Amravati (M.S.)

Kasturba Solar Khadi Mahila Samiti is a women-led organization working in the tribal and rural belt of Amravati district, Maharashtra. We provide sustainable livelihood to nearly 300 village women, by skilling them to operate a Solar Charkha and integrating the backward and forward linkages in the solar-spun yarn and fabric production process. The social enterprise is implemented with the kind support and mentorship of Maharashtra State Khadi and Village Industries Board (MSKVIB). The new concept of khadi developed by women has given thousands of women the opportunity to get sustainable employment and become financially self-sufficient. The Green Fab Solar Khadi Processing Cluster project based on the concept of Cotton to Textile has been set up at MIDC, Amravati with the help of various government agencies like KVIB and District Industries Center under the **Maharashtra State Industrial Cluster Development Program of Directorate of Industries.**



Traditional khadi garments are said to be lagging behind in the current era of branded garments. but in reality women power has taken a huge leap by fighting the flow competently. Solar Khadi Processing is the only project in the entire country. Women in rural areas of the district have shown what women power can do.

The movement of making khadi garments from the cotton of the local farmers in the district to did not took place in a day or two. Initially, the Khadi Village Industries Board implemented the concept of **solar charkhas** in rural areas for the propagation of khadi. It provided employment opportunities to women. As this initiative started getting good response, it was decided to reach the next stage. But there were many obstacles. Despite this, the women decided not to back down and through the Kasturba Khadi Women's Committee, 246 women from the rural areas of the district

came together and took the movement forward. Instead of handing over the yarn made by the women of the district to others, it was decided to process it and make cloth and garments from it.



As it was necessary to set up a competent system, Green Fab Solar Khadi Processing Cluster Pvt. Ltd. was set up in MIDC area of Amravati. A common facility center has been set up here under the scheme of the state government in which all the machinery required from cotton to textile manufacturing has been set up. Sliver Plant, Weaving, Fabric Dyeing, Bleaching, Block Printing, RND Lab ,Testing centre, Skill Manpower Training Centre facilities have been made available. With the setting up of these centers, the chain from cotton to fashion garments has been developed. What is special is that such a decentralized center is only at Amravati district in India. Decentralization has provided employment to hundreds of people in small investment. The cluster produces fashionable garments from khadi fabrics with the help of designers as well as handkerchiefs from children's clothing.

Yarn production through solar spinning wheel

Through Maharashtra State Board of Khadi and Village Industries, Amravati, 246 solar charkhas have been distributed in 21 centers in Amravati and Dharani talukas of Amravati district.

Since solar spinning wheels run on renewable energy, electricity is saved and solar spinning wheels allow women to produce more yarn with less labor and also produce better quality yarn on this spinning wheel. What is special is that all these projects are being done through women.

Production of Organic Khadi from the project

About a hundred of farmers in the district have been connected to the project. All these farmers grow organic cotton, from which cotton is bought and from which organic khadi cloth is made.

What is special about this fabric is that it is given a natural color from flowers, fruits etc. So no chemicals are used in this fabric. A system has also been set up to recycle the water wasted after dyeing the fabric. Therefore, care is also taken to maintain the balance of the environment.

This project has created a distinct identity of Amravati district at the global level and in future this project will create a lot of employment opportunities for women and thereby help women in the district to become financially capable.

CONCLUSION

- Empowerment of women is responsibility of any government, that could be achieved with people participation with strategic planning. Rural entrepreneurship has become a major opportunity for people resident of the rural areas. It is an effective instrument of social and economical development to generate employment and to earn the money.
- > The proper education and access to resources with technical and conceptual skill is making easy for starters to initiate. Launching of new schemes by govt. is essential in this regard to get adequate knowledge.
- Establishing Rural Research and training Institutes in rural areas may lead to stop migration of labor force to urban areas and Entrepreneurs may develop a business plan in accordance with opportunity available. As such the study of rural entrepreneurship becomes more vital in the present context.
- > Income generation through Value addition of local resources like agro products should promoted to avoid the middle trading sources
